

East) had a population of 10,396 whereas electoral district No. 36 Stanley (now part of Constituency No. 19 - Stanley and Rose Hill) had a population of 23,210.

- 3.3 The ratio between these two electoral districts in terms of population was already 1:2 in the 1962 census. The disparity has not been reduced if we look at the number of inhabitants according to subsequent census from 1978 to 2011, the latest census.

#### 4.0 POPULATION CENSUS

- 4.1 The table hereunder shows the number of inhabitants in respect of each constituency as per the population census for the years **1972, 1983, 1990, 2000 and 2011**.
